Eligibility:
The competition is open to ALL skaters who are current eligible (ER 1.00) members of either the Learn to Skate USA Program and/or are full members of U.S. Figure skating. To be eligible, skaters must have submitted a membership application or be a member in good standing. Members of other organizations are eligible to compete but must be registered with the host Learn to Skate USA program/club or any other Learn To Skate USA program/club.

Eligibility will be based on skill level passed or one level up as of closing date of entries. All Snowplow and Learn to Skate USA Basic 1-6 skaters must skate at highest level passed or one level higher and NO official U.S. Figure Skating tests may have been passed including MIF or individual dances.

For the Free Skate 1-6 and Well Balanced levels, eligibility will be based only upon highest free skate test level passed (moves in the field test level will not determine skaters competitive level). Skaters may skate at highest level passed OR one level higher BUT not both levels in the same event during the same competition.

Coaches:

U.S. Figure Skating Rule MR 5.11 Coach Compliance

In order to be granted access to work within U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned activities, each coach must complete the following requirements on an annual basis by July 1st:

- A. Must be a current full member of U.S. Figure Skating - either through a member club or as an individual member.
- B. Must complete the coach registration process through the U.S. Figure Skating Members Only site, submit proper payment for the annual registration fee of \$30 and, if 18 years of age or older, successfully pass the background screen.
- C. SafeSport training completed (for coaches/instructors 18 years old and older)
- D. Must complete the appropriate CER courses depending on the highest level of students being coached as of July 1. See rule MR 5.12.
- E. Must submit proof of current general liability insurance with limits of \$1 million per occurrence \$5 million aggregate
- F. For Learn To Skate USA coaches only- any person, 18 and older, instructing in a U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills/Learn To Skate USA Program must have successfully passed the annual background screen and be registered as a Basic Skills/Learn to Skate USA instructor member

First Event \$60

Judging:

The 6.0 Majority Judging System will be used for all events.

Refunds Policy: No refunds will be granted after the close of entries unless the event or competition is cancelled. The online processing fees are non-refundable.

Contested credit card charges will be assessed a \$25 fee. Payment of the fee will be required before the skater is allowed to participate in the competition. There are no refunds for medical withdrawals.

Registration:

A registration desk will be at the entrance to the ice arena on the days of the competition. All competitors must check in at the registration desk 60 minutes prior to their scheduled event. If the competition is running ahead of schedule some events may begin up to 15 minutes early.

Music:

Please provide CDs only. CDs must be turned into the registration desk and please make sure CDs are clearly labeled with the skater's name and event. Only one song per CD. No CD-RW CDs. Don't forget to bring a back up CD for emergencies. Please pick up your music at the completion of your event. All music left at the end of the competition will be discarded after one week.

Awards:

All skaters will receive an award. Individual awards will be given after the

posting of the results of each event.
